Our age-appropriate discussions take place while students perform hands-on tasks with the animals, allowing for a compelling, interactive and fun learning experience.



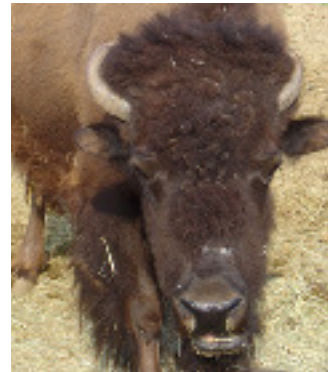
